For the first time in the area, the AtlantiCare Lung Nodule Clinic gives patients and referring physicians the option for detailed lung evaluation, on site. Located in Egg Harbor Township, the clinic is fully equipped for exploratory and interventional bronchoscopy.

Amit Borah, M.D. is the area's first full-time Interventional Pulmonologist. His expertise has significantly expanded AtlantiCare's pulmonology service into this new non-surgical area of medical subspecialty. His training is in minimally-invasive tools and techniques for diagnosing and managing lung nodules, masses, infection, inflammation and other problems associated with both acute and chronic pulmonary conditions.

Dr. Borah is boarded in internal medicine, pulmonary medicine and critical care medicine. A native of Philadelphia, he completed his internal medicine residency and a fellowship in pulmonary and critical care at Drexel University College of Medicine. He served a mentorship with Dr. Emil Abramian at Drexel, before completing an interventional pulmonology fellowship at Cooper University Hospital.

The Lung Nodule Clinic team reviews each case to determine the course of action that best serves you and your patient. Once the nodule is discovered, if surgery is not immediately indicated, Dr. Borah will investigate the nodule to determine its characteristics and biopsy it, as needed. The team will then make its recommendation for follow up or additional intervention, as needed.

Before AtlantiCare's clinic was established, patients at the southern New Jersey shore area in need of interventional pulmonology care had to travel outside the region. The clinic saves travel time and provides convenience for your patients while increasing the speed of diagnostic information for you and your team.
